Yes, our college has management Information System. It uses Vriddhi Software for Admission, Examination Department and for student database E- Granthalya Software for college Library. The use of information technology in educational management has rapidly increased due to its efficiency and effectiveness. In the initial stages of its development, management information systems (MIS) main purpose and usage was to improve the efficiency of college office activities. It was used to store personnel data of the student. The most concern was being focused on data entry and collation, rather than upon data transfer or analysis. The value of management information was recognized during its integration stages. Overall review of literature highlighted positive impact of MIS on college administration and management including better accessibility. The college has been using *Vriddhi* software, which covers all administrative aspects as admission, examination, etc. The data collected through software is processed and analyzed for various report generations as creating results, admission receipt, hall tickets, examination time table etc. Fees collection receipts are created and all financial details as daily collection and collection under different heads are created and submitted to the accounts department for further process. The library uses E- Granthalya software for creating database of books. Software is used to Bar-coding, issue and return books
